

FAQs Westhill

- **How long is Westhill's school day?**

- Preschool - Kindergarten is from **8:00 am to 1:00 pm**
- 1st grade to 5th grade is from **7:40 am to 2:40 pm**
- 6th grade to 12th grade is from **7:30 am to 3:15 pm**

All our afternoon activities are:

- Kinder from **1:30 pm to 2:30 pm**
- Elementary from **3:00 pm to 4:00 pm**
- Middle School and High School from **4:00 pm to 5:00 pm**

- **Do students wear uniforms at Westhill?**

Yes, from Preschool to 9th grade, our students wear uniforms. Students wear a formal school uniform on Mondays and uniforms the rest of the week.

Also as an American International School, we have a House System and sporting activities are completed in our four Houses: **Jaguars (Blue), Bobcats (Red), Lynxes (Green), Pumas (Yellow).**

- **Are students required to ride the bus?**

Riding the bus is optional and the fees for the bus service are separate.

Most of our families opt-into our bus service, and we have many bus routes serving areas that include **Polanco, Interlomas, Lomas de Chapultepec, Santa Fe, and others.** Each bus has a driver and nanny who are specifically assigned to the route.

All bus pick-ups and drop-offs are done from door to door.

- **What afternoon activities does Westhill offer?**

Westhill offers four main sports: Volleyball, Soccer, Basketball and Swimming. All four compete in local leagues and also as an ASOMEX School.

Other recreational sporting activities for our younger students have been designed to teach them skills to participate in our four main sports, beginning in Elementary . We also offer Swimming, Ballet, Karate, Soccer (Villareal Soccer School).

Westhill also has clubs around the arts, academics, and other interests and hobbies like Chess, Robotics, Drama and Model UN.



- **How many students are in 1 classroom?**

The average number of students per class is between 15 and 18 children per class.

- **In which language is the instruction?**

Preschool, Middle School and High School the instruction is full English with the option of a second language.

Elementary is 60% English and 40% Spanish.
